

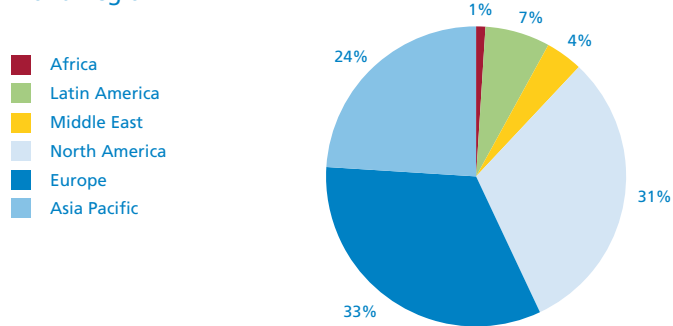

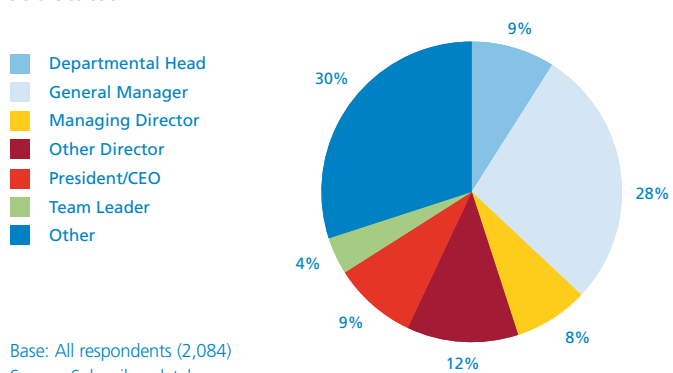

World Region



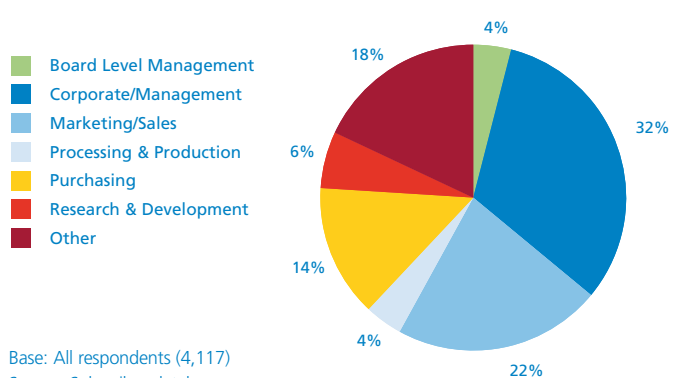

Job Status



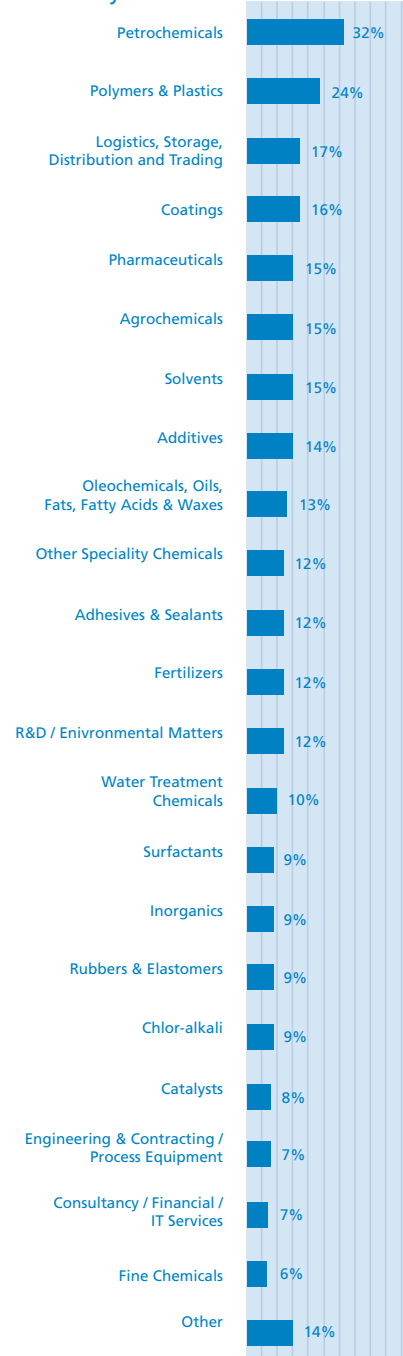
