



## Important Information for Students

If you are a student and wish to access EGi **you're in luck!** Chances are your university is already subscribed to the largest collection of researched property data available on the web!

In order to access EGi you will need to follow these easy steps:

### Step 1

Contact your librarian and ask for your university's username/password to access to EGi. *Please note: University username & passwords are supplied by your university librarian/IT Team; these will not be given out over the telephone under any circumstances.*

### Step 2

Go to [www.egi.co.uk](http://www.egi.co.uk) and fill out the registration form after the inputting your university's username and password.

### Step 3

Make sure you are using a **UNIVERSITY email address**. Once you have filled out the registration form, you will have a unique username and password and you will have access to EGi. You must use a university email address as proof of your student status or we will not be able to ensure continued access to EGi.

**Please note: If you are unable to use a university email address or wish to use a personal email address to access EGi, you will need to do the following:**

1. You can request permission by contacting our client support team ([client.support@egi.co.uk](mailto:client.support@egi.co.uk)) from a non university address and supply the new university username and password and also provide your enrolment and graduation date. Access will then be provided.

An example of the email that needs to be sent to gain access is as follows:
