NEW TRIPS FOR OVER-50s

HISTORY IN THE US CAPITAL REGION

Clients can take a deep-dive into US revolutionary history on this visit to the Capital Region with Newmarket. Groups will visit Colonial Williamsburg and the site of the first permanent English settlement in 1607, Jamestown. After a jaw-dropping journey along the Blue Ridge Parkway there's a stop in Washington DC, to take in the Lincoln Memorial and the White House, before heading to Baltimore to learn about the history of the American national anthem.

Book it: The 11-night trip costs from £1,868 per

person, based on a September 19 departure from

Heathrow, including flights.

With the Pope extending the Camino de Santiago's Holy Year into 2022, due to Covid, this year is set to be busy for the famous pilgrimage route. Clients can avoid the crowds with a journey north along the quieter Spanish paths of the Portuguese Camino, from picturesque Tui on the banks of the River Minho and through Galicia to the shrine of St James – staying in premium hotels and tasting wine and seafood along the way.

CASTLES. CITIES AND CHEESE

As well as providing a home for some impressive wildlife, from majestic red deer to shaggy Highland cows, the Isle of Skye has served as the backdrop for famous films such as Roald Dahl's BFG, Flash Gordon and King Arthur: Legend of the Sword. And clients can strap on a pair of walking boots to see the sweeping coves, glens and waterfalls in real life on this new HF Holidays tour.

Book it: A seven-night walking trip with HF Holidays on August 13 costs from £1,599, including all meals, but not flights. hfholidays.co.uk



MURDER MYSTERY
