


GODS AND PHARAOHS

After seeing strong sales for Tui Al Horeya, which launched last month, Tui River Cruises will add a second ship on the Nile, Tui Bahareya, in November 2025. EGYPTOLOGY ON TAP

NILE IN STYLE

Luxury hotel brand Oberoi has a roster of launches on the water next year, including two sailing ships due to debut in the second half of 2025. *Melouk* and *Malekat* are inspired by *dahabiyya* barges – a traditional boat that dates back to the time of the pharaohs – and each will transport 14 passengers between Luxor and Aswan.
