HAVE AN IRISH ADVENTURE

Fancy getting the gift of the gab – courtesy of a kiss of the ol' Blarney stone – then filling your Instagram feed with snaps of the Cliffs of Moher, kicking back on the Dingle Peninsula 's windswept beaches or dancing a jig in Ennis, all in a long weekend? Shamrocker's Southern Rocker Tour – ranked as the world's best multi-day tour by TripAdvisor – packs all this into just three days. Add the Burren's lunar-like landscape, a night in Killarney and stops in Dublin and Galway City, and you've got the makings of a true Irish experience.

Book it: The three-day trip starts at £209 including two nights' B&B hostel accommodation and transport. shamrockeradventures.com

SEE NORTHERN LIGHTS IN ICELAND

Skip Reykjavik and head to the lesser-known north, where the wild scenery is interrupted only by the occasional fishing village or lighthouse. Super Break runs the only direct charter flights to Akureyri, from where clients can view the northern lights and visit boiling mud pools at Namafjall. If they have time, suggest driving the Arctic Coast Way, a new 560-mile route across northern Iceland. **Book it:** Super Break's three and four-night Incredible North Iceland trips operate from 11 airports from February 3-March 16. Short sailings offer a taste of life on the water. RELAX ON THE MOROCCAN COAST

She says: "The best thing about this hotel is its fantastic activities, including a links golf course, paintballing, gokarting, quad biking on the beach, horse riding and a beautiful spa."

TAKE A SCENIC STAYCATION

If clients are short on time, forget the flight and make a beeline for the British countryside instead. The Lake District is big on epic landscapes, vast glassy lakes, and charming towns such as Windermere, which is a good base for scenic walks.
