# HOW TO SELL FESTIVE FAMILY HOLIDAYS

Always book early for Christmas and New Year, so if clients have missed the boat for this year, offer to book for 2020 - it'll give them more time to save and something to look forward to next year.

Check whether festive extras are included in the price – Christmas Day dinners and special activities often come at a supplement on top of the usual rate.
