

Clients looking for a beachside retreat? Laura French picks out the most impressive resorts and villas from the jewel of the Med

ith Cyprus having reopened its borders to Brits on August 1 and Jet2holidays putting the island back on sale, clients might well be looking to flock to its sunny

The range of accommodation has gradually expanded in recent years to include everything from from traditional, rustic villas to blow-the-budget resorts now available for clients who want cultural experiences and lively resort towns. But with so many hotels and villas to choose from, how do you know where to start? We've rounded up some of the standouts



VILLA STELLA MARIS. POMOS

Set at the foothills of the Troodos mountains, this recently-renovated spot gets 10/10 on the scenery front, with views overlooking a dramatic, craggy coastline and steps leading down to a quiet, pebbled cove lapped by glistening blue waters. It's handily located, with the remote, authentically Cypriot village of Pomos close by – think laid-back locals and a sleepy harbour where boats bob peacefully on the ripples - and the bigger, livelier resort of Polis a short drive away. The villa itself has three bedrooms, a terrace and private pool, and sits next to sister property Villa Buffavento, which can be booked in tandem for larger

COLUMBIA BEACH RESORT. PISSOURI BAY

For a luxury stay in the heart of the action, suggest Columbia Beach Resort, set right in front of Pissouri Bay, where paragliding, windsurfing, sailing and other watersports take place on cerulean shores. Diving, cycling, golf and other pursuits are also on hand in the local area, while the Hebe Spa offers a pool, Jacuzzi and sauna for those who'd rather relax. Kids' clubs and family-friendly activities make it a good bet for those travelling with little ones, while seven bars and restaurants ensure they're unlikely to go hungry.

ASTERIAS BEACH HOTEL ΔΥΙΔ ΝΔΡΔ

Set among 15 acres of landscaped gardens in front of Makronissos Beach, this upscale four-star is a good bet for families or couples wanting to be close to the action without being in the heart of it. Ayia Napa is a 10-minute drive away, but the emphasis is firmly on peace and tranquillity, with a spa, gourmet seafood restaurant and cocktail lounge among the facilities, plus tennis courts, watersports and other activities on hand to keep kids busy. "It occupies a magnificent and secluded location, fringed by one of the island's finest beaches." says Harry Kyrillou, commercial and aviation director at Planet Holidays. "It's family-run and offers an amazing all-inclusive scheme with excellent evening

ADAMS BEACH HOTEL. AYIA NAPA


Nissi Beach has earned itself a reputation among the partygoers of the world thanks to its central location (next to Ayia Napa) and head-turning views – think pearl-white sand drifting into a stretch of glittering turquoise. Among its crop of deluxe waterfront stays is Adams Beach Hotel, a five-star hotel set among emerald gardens, featuring five freeform swimming pools (with a lazy river and waterslides) plus a spa, swim-up bar and nine other bars and restaurants. "It's a really impressive hotel, fringed by the golden sands of Nissi Bay with an atmosphere of elegance and charm," says Ricky Wason, product manager for Olympic Holidays. "There are excellent dining options and plenty of family activities to keep younger guests busy too." GREECE & CYPRUS | BEACHFRONT STAYS



LIMNI BEACH VILLA, POLIS

For a peaceful, authentically Cypriot town that's kept its charm without being totally cut off, Polis is an excellent option, with a family-friendly, sandy beach close to the Akamas Peninsula and its crystal-clear blue lagoon. There's a handful of picturesque properties in the area but for one of the best, look to Limni Beach, a stylish, contempory-design villa that offers direct access to the beach and has its own (sizeable) pool and barbecue area as well as a gym, and four bedrooms spread across two floors. It's a short stroll from the town centre, and if clients want a bit more buzz, Paphos is easily reachable in less than an hour by car.

Book it: Oliver's Travels offers a week from £1,855 (for travel between September 30 and March 24, 2021).

BEST OF THE REST

Villa Karavi, Pomos: For a secluded retreat away from it all, try this four-bedroom pad on the outskirts of Pomos. It's surrounded by sweeping mountain scenery and features several unusual quirks, including an underwater bedroom set beneath the pool with portholes looking into it, as well as direct beach access and a spacious private garden.

Annabelle Hotel, Paphos: Thanos Hotels' Annabelle has achieved legendary status and for good reason, with an elegant design that's all about the serenity, Cypriot touches like local live music, and ample food and drink options – from a rooftop bar overlooking the ocean to gourmet restaurants focused on local produce. For those wanting to go beyond the beach, the quaint cobbled Old Town of Paphos is a short stroll away.

Elias Beach Hotel, Limassol: Families, honeymooners and couples tying the knot are all catered for at this elegant all-inclusive set in the historic area of Amathus, with kids' clubs, a children's pool, cinema nights and plenty more drawing those with younger ones, and couples' spa treatments, gourmet restaurants and beach weddings adding appeal for romantic types. Limassol is a 15-minute drive away, bringing history, culture and a smattering of local tavernas into the mix.



CAPO BAY HOTEL, PROTARAS

Direct art lovers to this design-led retreat on the southeast coast, overlooking the iconic Fig Tree Bay – named among Europe's best beaches by TripAdvisor, with aquamarine water lapping a stretch of gold. It hosts frequent art exhibitions and boasts a stylish spa with sauna, Jacuzzi, pool, sanarium and more, while five themed bars and restaurants – including Bitter Lemons, which features changing lights and artistic visuals with the aim of helping guests recharge – keep guests well fed. Private candlelit beach dining and other romantic touches add allure for couples.
