ith the red list reduced, the amber list scrapped and testing restrictions eased, families that didn't manage to get away over summer might well be looking to jet off in the coming months – and for those that can't bear to wait much longer, it's not too late to book a last-minute escape for October half-term.

Turkey is back on the cards, so make the most of it by selling a stay at this splash-centric, all-inclusive resort in Antalya. Home to several pools, waterslides and two restaurants, it also offers access to Eftalia Island – a huge beachfront area where a separate water park, beach, children's play area, amphitheatre, restaurants and more await. 

#### TUI MAGIC LIFE KALAWY, EGYPT


