TURKEY SUMMER BREAKS

Steer clients towards the private beaches and waterparks of these top resorts, advises **Isobel Turner**



BOTANIK PLATINUM. ALANYA

Clients can kick back in style on Turkey's Turquoise Coast at plush Botanik Platinum, an exclusive area within the five-star Botanik Hotel & Resort. Platinum guests have their own indoor pool, but they can also access the 10 outdoor pools at the resort, including an adult-only option that's ideal for a more peaceful swim. A short wander down the tree-lined path brings guests to the hotel's private beach, while, back inside, they can reset with an hour or two of pampering in the spa's 'Cleopatra milk bath', hammam or Jacuzzi.

Book it: A week all-inclusive costs £1,231, including luggage, transfers and flights from Bristol on July 13. easyjet.com

ATLANTIQUE HOLIDAY CLUB, KUŞADASI

Family fun awaits at Atlantique Holiday Club, on the Kuṣadasi coast. Clients can soak up the sun poolside on sunbeds or cool off in one of two freshwater pools – one is adult-only, the other has a children's section. They can also burn off some energy at Tortuga Pirate Island Aqua Park, to which Atlantique guests have free, unlimited access. Options include racing down the 14 waterslides or taking a dip in the pirate's pool, while the evening entertainment spans everything from bingo to karaoke.
