


WINTER HOLIDAYS

Sun, snow or sea? Explore a range of winter options for a family escape, says **Alice Barnes-Brown**

hen it comes to winter family getaways, there is no one-size-fits-all approach. Some clients might fly south in search of sun or set sail for balmier climes, while others choose to embrace the chill to make snowy memories.

With Christmas just 10 weeks away and February half-term following quickly on its heels, now's the perfect time to set your clients' sights on a fabulous winter break. Whether they want to pack their bags for a far-flung festive adventure or are looking for an antidote to February's dark nights, we've rounded up the best short and long-haul options for this winter.







MONASTIR, TUNISIA

Tunisia is an excellent option for a winter family holiday on a budget. With plenty of sunshine and a sea temperature of almost 20C in December – so clients who dare can take a dip in the Med – Monastir is an ideal base. The Hilton Skanes Monastir Beach Resort has direct beachfront access. Parents and older children will find plenty to do come rain or shine, with one indoor and three outdoor pools; a tennis court; a teen club stocked with balls, consoles and board games; and nightly entertainment. Little ones have an all-weather world of their own to enjoy, including a kids' club and a toddler splash park.

COLORADO. US

Less than two hours from Denver airport, the family-friendly ski resort of Breckenridge offers dog-sled rides, while children can be enrolled in ski school from the age of three. Indoor days can be enriching too, with the Mountain Top Explorium offering fun scientific experiments. The ski-in, ski-out Beaver Run Resort's options for when families aren't on the slopes include a pool, mini-golf and an arcade.

LAPLAND, FINLAND

Inghams has expanded its Lapland programme to offer full-board packages in Saariselkä – making its sweeping snowscapes better value for families. Set in a secluded spot is the Wilderness Hotel Muotka, where families can fill their days with snowmobile safaris, fat-tyre biking, snowshoe walks through the frozen lakeland or even cross-country skiing. Cabins with private saunas mean children can warm up the Nordic way before bedtime, or suggest clients book a glass-domed cabin for aurora borealis-spotting opportunities.
